Olympic Recognition - Procedure

❖ Criteria

- Signatory to WADA Code
- Member of SportAccord
- Recognize Court of Arbitration jurisdiction
- Only Federation governing the sport worldwide
- Have existed for at least 5 years
- Summer have a minimum of 50 members (Winter 25)
- Conform to Rule 25 of the Olympic Charter

Olympic Recognition - Procedure

❖ Respect following general principles

- Monitor health, address education, non-discrimination, fair play and solidarity
- Youth a key focus, world events
- Judging and marking system transparent
- Take into consideration the interest of women practising the sport

Olympic Recognition - Criteria

- ❖ 54 specific questions to respond to covering the following general areas:
 - General (Value add)
 - Governance / Strategic Planning / Gender Equity / Betting
 - History and Tradition (start date / World Events)
 - Universality (members, geographic spread)
 - Popularity (Youth appeal / spectators / media / broadcasts)
 - Athletes (Entourage, representation, commission)
 - Development (programmes, technical evolution, equity)
 - Finance (Audit, Income & Expenditure)

Olympic Recognition - Decision

- Formal advice of application
- Submit complete file prior to 1st October
- SportAccord will analyse on behalf of IOC
- Basis for IOC to review, IOC Exec Board can grant provisional recognition of 2 years
- Then to IOC session for full recognition
- IOC Exec Board reviews once a year.
