**World Under 19 Championships (Men)- Finland Turku July 12-21,2012**

Ron Balls gave an update on this event which includes 12 teams:

5 teams in top division.

Canada, Australia, Iroquois, USA, and England.

7 teams in two other groups.

Czech Republic, Finland, Netherlands, Germany, Scotland, Wales, Korea.

- Coaches meeting 11 July. Location to be advised
- Mailing to be sent out this week covering details including uniform selections, Player Registration forms, etc.
- Possible change in location for second facility

**World Cup (Women) - Canada**

**Oshawa July 11-20, 2013**

Shelley Maher connected via Skype to Cheryl MacNeill, co-coordinator of 2013 World Cup.

- All fields are spectacular. Playing fields are turf with permanent lines.
- 4 changing rooms will be available. (incoming teams and outgoing teams)
- 1 warm-up field for busy days so scheduling will be important.
- Housing facility is a dorm, 10 min from field. Accommodation is a 2 bedded room - \$100 per day(\$50 per person). Meal package will be \$35 per day per person (3 meals). Fridge microwave and coffee maker available but no other cooking facilities. TV Lounge also provided.
- The first newsletter will be sent out once country contacts are finalised, ~ 1st Sept and monthly thereafter.

TV package will be with 2007 Rogers, a community cable broadcast which can be seen Province wide. Webcasting will be set up for all games.

**Co-events.**

- Festival of Games. International teams (12 - 14 July)
- CLA National Invitational U19 (15-17 July) Ontario followed by U11, U13 teams (19-21 July)
- Wheelchair lxx from USA - games on site, support of CLA and Trillium Foundation
- 2012, July 13-15. North American Cup involving Canada, US, Haudenosaunee will be a round-robin tournament to provide a technical run-through.

Shelly Maher and/or Cheryl Mac Neill responded to questions:

- FIL entry fee will be \$1300 per team entry (Canadian dollars)
- Room and Board will be \$85pppn (players and coaches)
- Officiating costs shared by all countries participating
- Banquet -\$75-100 per athlete
- Airport transport is to be arranged by the host as part of the contract.
- Laundry can be done on a daily basis and each team will get cards (working on a detergent sponsorship.)
- There will be an on-site athletic therapy center with team access. There will also be a pharmacy on site with doctors available to provide prescriptions.
- Pool on-site at civic reception complex, working out details to have access to the pool.
- Costs for the festival will be \$1500 per team, access to all World Cup games, up to 20 athletes per team.
- Costs of officiating share will be similar to 2011+10% - \$4,000.

### **World Championships (Men)- US**

**Denver July 10-19, 2014**

Steve Stenersen introduced Bill Schoonmaker and Beth Porreca.

A promotional video from Denver was shown. It has been 16 years since USA last hosted an event for men. A decision had been taken to move away from the traditional lacrosse areas to provide a springboard for lacrosse development in the West. Bill delivered a power point presentation.

- Accommodation will be at Denver University.
- Fields at Dicks Sporting Goods Park (DSGP) 16miles away. Travel time will be 25 to 45 mins.
- USA to provided transport for teams in competition
- DSGP has 24 fields and a 20,000 seat stadium, turf and grass (stadium).
- Locker rooms available in the stadium, no locker rooms on other fields
- Denver University is a Division 1 College. Dorm-like housing, spread throughout campus. Cost vary based on with or without air conditioning
- Check-in 30 June, check out 21 July (min/max)
- Catering is available on campus
- Training venue at Denver University is the Ritchie Athletic Centre for team practices. 1 grass and 1 turf field.
- Physio. Room available at DU.
- The Athletic Centre is 5 min walk from all dorms.
- University can provide a laundry service.
- College area has lots of services within walking distance.
- Officials to be housed in the Johnson & Wales College not at Denver University.
- Host hotel for the FIL General Assembly will be Marriott Renaissance. (10min to DSGP.)
- Sept 28-29 2013 - all FIL delegates are invited for a preview of the site
- Festival registration to begin in December

Bill handed out a USB stick pre-loaded with presentation about Denver to all countries.

Steve Stenersen talked about challenges to US

- Huge event- budget \$4.4. Projected to accrue a \$200.000 loss. Facility costs \$1.2million to rent
- FIL guidelines suggest that teams can commit up to 6months prior to event. However, USL needs earlier commitment. At least one year. The draw and schedule (or parts of) need to be done sooner rather than later in order to sell tickets and seal media-partnership.
- 100 officials are required for the championships.
- Japan- asked about effects of high-altitude, medical concerns and encounters, any studies on how many days to adjust to altitude for athletes and extreme sports
- Beth said she could provide US Olympic studies re altitude training. She can provide docs, signs and symptoms of altitude sickness and how to train. All this information is in the public domain.
- Elevation is 6000ft in Denver.

#### **World Indoor Championships(Men)-Iroquois Syracuse/Buffalo Sept.18 – 26, 2015**

Neal Powless and Gewas Schindler presented a powerpoint

Syracuse venue is Onondaga Nation arena, 5miles from Syracuse city centre.

Buffalo venue is First Niagara Arena

Dates have been moved to September to improve attendance of pro players.

#### **Questions:**

- Fundraising/merchandising for teams will be possible in Onondaga. Discussion required with Buffalo.
- 8-12 countries are expected. New teams and developing nations welcome. Before the event friendly matches with local teams can be organised. Lots of opportunities to scrimmage
- teams arriving early to practice can be accommodated.
- Canada has provided clinics for players and officials and will help with this event as well.
- Working on an official hotel in both Syracuse and Buffalo,
- Hope to organise a Festival alongside the main event and arrange youth matches between games.

#### **World Under 19 Championships(Women) – Scotland Edinburgh, July 23-Aug 1, 2015**

- Lorna Powell presented a power point about the event.
- She thanked FIL for accepting the bid from Scotland.
- University of Edinburgh will serve as the host institution. The University of Edinburgh is used to large numbers and diversity.
- Support will come from the City of Edinburgh and Sportscotland.
- University fields are 10 minute walk from dorms at Peffermill grounds

**World Under 19 Championships (Men) -Canada Coquitlam, B.C. July 7 – 16, 2016**

- Awarded to Coquitlam, BC
- Bids had come from Coquitlam and Poland who were hosting the World Games in 2017)
- The venue will be the same as that used in 2008 with 4 artificial turf fields. These were renovated in 2010.
- Accommodations will be at Simon Fraser University
- A Youth Invitational will run alongside
