3	20.13	Delete 20.13. Insert 20.14.
4 & 86	24.H.1	Red card suspension - delete 6. Insert 8. Red card suspension = 8 penalty points.
29	10.H	Each team may request two 90 seconds time outs during regulation play and one time out during overtime. Time outs not used during regulation play are not permitted during overtime. A team may request a time out after a goal is scored or when <b>her</b> team has possession of a 'dead ball' anywhere on the field outside the 15m <b>area</b> . The coach may request a time out through the score table or the player who is given possession of the ball may request a time out directly through a field umpire.
30	11 New 2017	Following a goal, <b>substitutes must not enter the field, nor players on the field leave, until after the goal scorer's crosse has been checked and deemed legal.</b>
34	12.A.1 New 2017	To draw, two opponents stand with one foot toeing the center line. Their crosses are held in the air above hip level, parallel to and above the center line. Both the head and shaft must lie along the vertical plane of the center line. <b>The hand at the bottom of the player's shaft cannot be higher than the hand at the top of the shaft. The butt end of the shaft cannot be lower than 30 degrees from being parallel with the ground.</b> The crosses will be held back to back, the right sidewall is down, so that each player's crosse is between the ball and the goal she is defending. A player's top hand may not contact the throat, the pocket or the sidewall of her crosse (Rule 19.A.1)
36	12.C.1	If a medical person is on the field, the player must leave the field.
37	13.C.9	A player who scores a goal must immediately drop her crosse to allow the umpire to confirm it is legal.
	13.C.9	Renumber 13.C.10. Delete (Rule 19.A.16). Insert (Rule 19.A.15)
	13.C.10 New 2017	If the player who shot the goal <b>does not drop her crosse, or hand her crosse to the nearest official in a timely fashion, or any team mate adjusts the goal scorer's crosse after an umpire's request to inspect the crosse, the crosse will be removed from the game</b> (Rule 19.A.15). <b>The goal will not be permitted as the crosse is illegal</b> (13.C.8).
	13.C.10	Renumber 13.C.11. Delete (Rule 19.A.18). Insert (Rule 19.A.17)

49	17.C.1 New 2017	<b>Delete – refer page 3, Rule 17.C.</b> With two exceptions below, when the defense commits any goal circle foul, the

		<p>attack will be awarded a <b>major foul</b> free position at the <b>11m</b> mark on the goal line extended that is nearest to the foul. Unless it is the goalkeeper, the defender who fouled will move 4m behind where the <b>15m</b> fan intersects the goal line.</p> <p>Exceptions to the rule: The goalkeeper would not go behind and would abide by goal circle penalties in Rule 17C.1.a, and an illegal deputy penalized for a major foul, Rule 17.C.1.b.</p>
58	19.18	Delete (See Rule 20.A.14). Insert (See Rule 20.A.15)
66	20.15	Delete (See Rule 19.A.19). Insert (See Rule 19.A.18)
69	21.A.1	The advantage flag area includes the 15m area and the playing area behind the goal that runs <b>12m</b> deep and 15m to each side of the center of the goal line.
73	22.A.1 New 2017	<b>Renumber 1-6 to a-f</b>
73	22.A.2 New 2017	<p><b>A coach, manager or other bench personnel must not:</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. <b>Coach leaves their coaching area.</b></li> <li>b. <b>Use abusive language or exhibit behavior that is intended to embarrass, ridicule or demean others, i.e. baiting or taunting.</b></li> <li>c. <b>Exhibit any type of behavior which in the umpire's opinion amounts to misconduct.</b></li> </ol>
73	22.B.1 last sentence New 2017	Whenever a warning card is shown, it is considered a warning to all players <b>and bench personnel.</b>
73	22.B.1 New 2017	2 <sup>nd</sup> & 3 <sup>rd</sup> paragraph, move to 22.A.2
73	22.B.1.a New 2017	<p><b>When any team bench personnel receive a yellow card:</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>i) <b>A player from the offending team who is closest to their substitution area must be removed from the field.</b></li> <li>ii) <b>Her team must play with one less player below/goal side of the restraining lines for the duration of the two minute penalty. This penalty is served by the team and not the player who was removed from the field.</b></li> <li>iii) <b>Once play resumes, any eligible player may substitute as long as her team plays with one less player on the field for the duration of the two minute penalty.</b></li> <li>iv) <b>Umpires must ensure that the offending team is onside before restarting play. If necessary a player who is nearest to the restraining line below/goal side will move back onside.</b></li> </ol>
	22.B.1.c n New 2017	<p><b>When any team bench personnel receives a yellow/red or straight red card:</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>i) <b>The suspended person will be requested to leave the field and the entire playing area.</b></li> <li>ii) <b>A player from the offending team who is closest to their substitution area must be removed from the field.</b></li> </ol>

		<p>iii) Her team must play with one less player below/goal side of the restraining lines for the duration of the five minute (yellow/red) or ten minute penalty (straight red) penalty. This penalty is served by the team and not the player who was removed from the field.</p> <p>iv) Once play resumes, any eligible player may substitute as long as her team plays with one less player on the field for the duration of the five minute or ten minute penalty.</p> <p>v) Umpires must ensure that the offending team is onside before restarting play. If necessary a player who is nearest to the restraining line below/goal side will move back onside.</p>
